Alan George Agin, age 77 of Prattville passed away at home surrounded by family on April 4, 2022.

Alan, who was known as “Pawpaw” by his grandchildren, was born on July 23, 1944, to John and Roseanna (Wisher) Agin in Rhode Island. At age 17 he joined the military and went on to have a successful career as a master sergeant in the U.S. Air Force. In October 1966 he married the love of his life, Linda Peacock Agin.
