



Arthur Raymond Bridges

December 15, 1930 - April 3, 2023

Arthur Raymond Bridges (92) of Prattville, AL, formerly of Bonaire, Georgia, went to be with the Lord after a brief illness on April 3, 2023. He was a compassionate and kind man with a servant's heart; his generous spirit led him to be a strong advocate for those less fortunate.

As a strong proponent of education, he often encouraged his family to further their educational pursuits to the fullest extent possible. He often said that education was the one thing in life that could never be taken away from you.

He was born in Ellisville, Mississippi on December 15, 1930 and grew up in Carthage, MS.

He graduated from Barnes High School as the salutatorian in 1949. After high school, he

worked in construction before joining the US Air Force in 1951 and proudly served his country

for 23 years, retiring as a Senior Master Sergeant. During his Air Force tenure, he was

stationed in Georgia (3 times) , Newfoundland, Texas (twice), and the Philippine Islands. He

also served his country in both the Korean and Vietnam wars.

He met the love of his life, Helen Richardson Bridges, in 1953 and they married in 1954.

They were married for 60 years before her passing in 2014. He was a devoted caregiver during his wife's latest years.

After his Air Force career, he worked for 29 years as a TV Repairman at Rama TV in Warner

Robins, GA. He was a well respected TV serviceman during the time when these providers came to your house to fix your television.

After moving to Prattville in 2013, he enjoyed many events with his family and friends. His

love of cooking was enjoyed by all when he hosted home cooked meals.

Arthur was known for

his baking prowess, especially his homemade carrot cakes and chocolate chip cookies. He

remained active with daily neighborhood walks and loved taking care of the family's "furry friends."
