SCOGGINS, Robert "Bob" Lewis, 73, a resident of Prattville, AL, died peacefully at home on Tuesday, August 2, 2004, after an extended illness. Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, August 4, 2004, at 11:00 a.m., from the First Baptist Church in Prattville, with Dr. Travis Coleman and Dr. Fred Lackey officiating. Burial will follow in Prattville Memory Gardens, with Prattville Memorial Chapel directing. Mr. Scoggins honorably served his country as a Veteran of the United States Marine Corp during the Korean War and later served in the United States Air Force and the Alabama Air National Guard from which he retired after 33 years of service.
