Tatum, Clarence Saul, 97, a long time resident of Prattville, Al, passed away on Saturday, July 19, 2014. Funeral Services will be held at a Hunting Ridge Church of God on Tuesday, July 22, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. with Reverend Stephen Smith and Reverend Henry Williams from Hunting Ridge Church of God and Reverend Wayne Rouse from Uniontown Church of God officiating.
