NORMAN, Clayton Welton "C.W.", 78, passed away on Sunday, August 14, 2011 in Tampa, FL. Funeral services will be held on Saturday, August 20, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. from the Chapel of Prattville Memorial with Reverend Robert Hunnicutt officiating.
