



Colonel Lendon Hagan

September 4, 1942 - February 5, 2017

HAGAN, COLONEL LENDON of Prattville, AL went home to be with his Lord on February 5, 2017.

He is survived by his wife, Betty “Bo” Hagan; his daughters, Kelley Hagan Kirkland (Vince) and Susan Hagan Klinner (Bill, Jr.); his brother, Rev. Dr. Randy Hagan (Mary Alice); his grandsons, Ryan Kirkland (Lauralee), Matt Kirkland, Tyler Kirkland and Will Klinner; and nephews, Daniel Hagan (Christie) and Aaron Hagan (Jasmine). He was preceded in death by his parents, Leon and Sue Hagan.

Colonel Hagan began his service with the Alabama Department of Public Safety as a State Trooper Cadet in 1961 and rose through the ranks to become the Director of Public Safety in August 1996 and retired January 1999.

Colonel Hagan faithfully served the people of Alabama as a State Trooper, Intelligence Officer, ABI Investigator, Commander of the Criminal Justice Training Center, Commander of Missing Children’s Bureau and Chairman of the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission.

Visitation will be held from 1:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. at Heritage Baptist Church (1357 S. Memorial Drive, Prattville, AL 36067) on Wednesday, February 8, 2017. The funeral service will follow with Reverend Roger Parks and Reverend Randy Hagan presiding. Graveside service will follow at Prattville Memory Gardens (841 Fairview Avenue, Prattville, AL 36066) with the Alabama State Trooper Honor Guard presiding.
