HARTNELL, Delvin Lee, age 67, passed away on Sunday, January 31, 2016. Funeral services will be held on Thursday, February 4, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. from the Chapel of Prattville Memorial with Dr. Ken Jackson officiating. 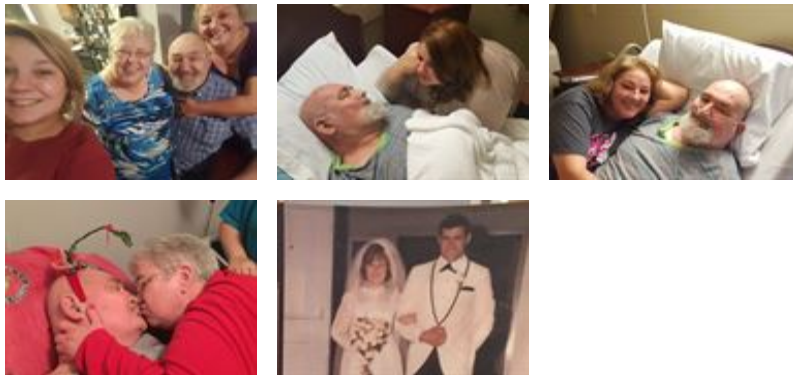
