Hutchinson, DeVanulis Fletcher, Jr., 86, a resident of Prattville, passed away on Tuesday, January 29, 2019. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. from Bethlehem Christian Methodist Episcopal Church with Dr. Albert Russell and Rev. Sam Gordon III officiating. Burial will follow in Prattville Memory Gardens. Mr. Hutchinson was a decorated war veteran. He proudly served his country in the United States Navy for 20 years and retired as a Chief Petty Officer. He served in World War II, Vietnam and Korean War. After his military career he went on to be a Postal Police Officer with US Postal Service.
