



## Dorothy Jean Bobo Stanley ("Bobo")

February 17, 1930 - August 23, 2024

Dorothy Jean Bobo Stanley ("Bobo") died August 23, 2024, after a lengthy battle with cancer. She was preceded in death by her husband, Dr. James Frederick Stanley of Prattville, AL; parents, Mr. and Mrs. G.A. Bobo, Sr. of Collinsville, AL; three brothers, William A. Bobo of Gadsden, AL, G.A. Bobo, Jr. of Longview, TX. and James S. Bobo of Gasden, AL; two sisters, Clara Ben Bobo Lumpkin of Gasden, AL and Elna Jane Bobo Wright of Collinsville, AL. She is survived by her three daughters, Carol Stanley of Northport, AL, Jeanne Stanley of Hoover, AL and Ruth Stanley of Prattville, AL; brother, Max S. Bobo of Hokes Bluff, AL; many nieces and nephews. She was born on February 17, 1930, and grew up on a farm outside Collinsville, AL. She graduated from Collinsville High School in 1948 as valedictorian of her class and received the DAR Good Citizenship Award. She attended the University of Alabama and received her registered nursing degree from Jefferson Hillman Hospital School of Nursing (currently UAB School of Nursing) in 1951. At graduation from nursing school, she received the award for Outstanding Student in the Art of Nursing. She married James Frederick Stanley, MD in 1953 and was happily married until his sudden death in 1978. She belonged to the First United Methodist Church of Prattville and was active in ministries including administrative board, meals on wheels and transportation of assisted living church members. She was a founding member of Prattville Study Club, belonged to a Bridge club, led Girl Scout Brownie troops, and took part in multiple other community organizations and activities. The funeral will be held

on Thursday, August 29, 2024 at 11:00 am at Prattville Memorial Chapel with Rev. Chris McCain officiating. The family will receive friends one-hour prior to the service.
