“ My condolences and prayers to the Lee family. Garry was one of the best examples of Agape - perfect love exemplified by God's love for humanity. He had the highest, most selfless, and unconditional form of love, characterized by deliberate choice, sacrifice, and seeking the best for others. He was my supervisor in the late 1970's. Being an Afro-American Northerner Computer Programmer from Buffalo, NY, was hard duty at Gunter Air Force Station at the time. I was in my early twenties. I continually dealt with unfair and terrible acts - cotton plant on desk; “called “N” word in front of co-workers; paper cross burned on my desk; and shunned by most everyone in the office. Garry would not tolerate that environment. He constantly stuck up for me and worked hard to fight upper management for me to ensure my survival. I will always love and admire him for my last breath for what he did for my life, family, and career.

Garry was a loyal and resolute friend. He loaned his 3-speed truck to move from base housing to off-base. I made back-and-forth trips. The clutch got stuck off base after midnight. I hated to call him late at night to let him know. But he, without hesitation, got off the phone and came to my house to fix the clutch. He asked me if I still needed the truck and I said yes but could manage without it since I messed it up once. He just got back in his car and went back home. That is the man he was. When he also met my mother, she instantly liked him. She always asked about him. Garry used that to his advantage. He would tell me that if I did not act right, he was going to call my mom; he was strategic in getting my mom on his side to manage me, which I needed at the time!

Although I am crying while I type this, I praise, appreciate, and thank God for giving Garry Lee!
