Lightsey, Gerald Lee, 69, a resident of Prattville, AL, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, April 8, 2017. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, April 11, 2017 from the Prattville Community Church at 11:00 a.m. with Reverend Lamar Golden officiating. Burial will follow in Prattville Memory Gardens. Mr. Lightsey served as Deputy Supreme Governor, State President and Secretary including all chairs for the 1864 Moose Lodge in Prattville where he held the Pilgrim Degree. He was co-owner and vice president of L&L painting for 35 years. He was preceded in death by his parents, Buford Lightsey and Doris Biesecker. 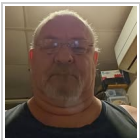
