FULLER, James Roy, 80, resident of Prattville, Alabama, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, January 30, 2018. Funeral service will be held on Saturday, February 3, 2018 at 11:00AM at Millbrook Church of the Nazarene. Burial will follow in Prattville Memory Gardens with Prattville Memorial directing. Dr. Fuller was preceded in death by his wife, Nina Sue (Schofield) Fuller, son, Stephen Paul Fuller; parents, C. Florida, Gadsden, Alabama and Panama City, Florida. He served as District Superintendent for 39 years on four districts: Italy, Quebec, Pittsburgh and Alabama South.
