James Richard (Dick) Huckaby passed away peacefully at home in Prattville, Alabama on November 14, 2025. Richard was born on May 29, 1937 in Birmingham, Alabama to Charles P and Pearl Huckaby. He was a graduate of Hewitt-Trussville High School where he played in the band and baseball. Richard earned both his Undergraduate degree and his Master's degree from Auburn University in 1961 and 1965 respectively.

Richard married Joan Jolly of Tallassee, Alabama on June 6, 1964. Richard and Joan were blessed with 61 years of marriage. He loved Joan fiercely and that love was a blessing on display up until his last breath.

Richard was a great lover of the outdoors and became a master gardener growing a variety of crops and plants. His tomatoes and peppers were legendary! Richard enjoyed fishing and golf as well as hiking and canoeing. He was an avid history buff and a lifelong learner up until his final days. Most importantly, Richard was a great father, husband and grandfather to his 8 grandchildren. Richard handmade all his grandchildren Christmas gifts each year when they were young from his wood shop he maintained with many made by the tools he inherited from his father. He was loved by his family immensely.

Richard was preceded in death by his older brother Phillip Huckaby and his younger sister, Janice Strange.

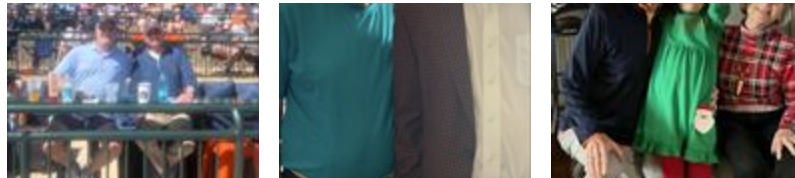
