HOWARD, John Wilson, 69, a resident of Prattville, AL, died peacefully on Tuesday, August 2, 2004, after an extended illness. Funeral services will be held on Friday, August 6, 2004, at 2:00 p.m., from St. Mark's Episcopal Church, with The Reverend Stephen DeGweck officiating. Burial will follow in Prattville Memory Gardens, with Prattville Memorial Chapel directing. Dr. Howard was a graduate of Sidney Lanier High School, Class of 1952, and was in the Sidney Lanier Marching Band. He earned a B. S. Degree from Auburn University; a Masters Degree and a Ph.D. from the University of Tennessee. He was an avid reader and a sports fan, following the Chicago Cubs and the Kentucky Wildcats.
