COOK, Jori Lyn, 20, of Prattville, AL, passed away on October 3, 2021 surrounded by family at Baptist South Hospital in Montgomery, AL. Jori's death is a result of injuries sustained in a single automobile accident that occurred on September 29, 2021. Jori was born on October 4, 2000, in Panama City Beach, FL.
