Al was born in Missouri and raised in Springfield, Ohio where he attended Possum High School. He received his Bachelor's Degree in Horticulture from The Ohio State University in 1955. He was a lifelong member of the Delta Chi Fraternity.

ROTC at Ohio State led him to the U.S. Air Force. He piloted many different aircraft during his 25-year Air Force career, notably the B-52 bomber, earning his Wing Commander status. Al was a Vietnam Veteran. He also spent several years flying and instructing in the HU-16 amphibious landing aircraft during an extended tour in Goose Bay, Labrador, Canada. He completed his career at Maxwell AFB as a Wing Chief at the Squadron Officer's School, earning a Meritorious Service Medal and helping to prepare over 900 officers in the defense of our country.

Al entered the real estate business after retiring in Prattville where he has enjoyed over 40 years promoting the city. He served the city of Prattville on various boards and committees. He was a Charter Member of the Autauga County Heritage Association and encouraged restoration of older properties. Old Prattvillage and Hunt's Alley are among his many enduring projects.

Preceded in death by the love of his life, wife Sheila, Al is survived by his four children, Steve (Mary Ann), Brian (Brenda) and Christopher (Tammy) Bock and daughter Lori (Richard) Terrell; grandchildren Emily, Andrew (Christina), Shelby and Mandy Bock and Matthew (Megan) Wilcox, and great-grands Turner Bock and Elijah Wilcox.

Al and Sheila were founding members of Christ Lutheran Church in Prattville and longtime members of Prattville First United Methodist Church where a memorial service will be held Saturday, April 13 at 11 a.m. Family will receive visitors there at 10 a.m.
