



## Mary Ellen Webber

July 6, 1925 - May 24, 2015

Mary Ellen (Stafford) Webber, 89, passed Sunday, May 24, 2015. Funeral services will be held at Prattville Memorial Chapel on Friday, May 29, 2015 at 2:00 PM, with son, Mark Webber and the Reverend Dave Burns officiating. Burial will follow at Prattville Memory Gardens with Prattville Memorial Chapel directing. Mrs. Webber was preceded in death by her husband, Reverend Harlan Webber.
