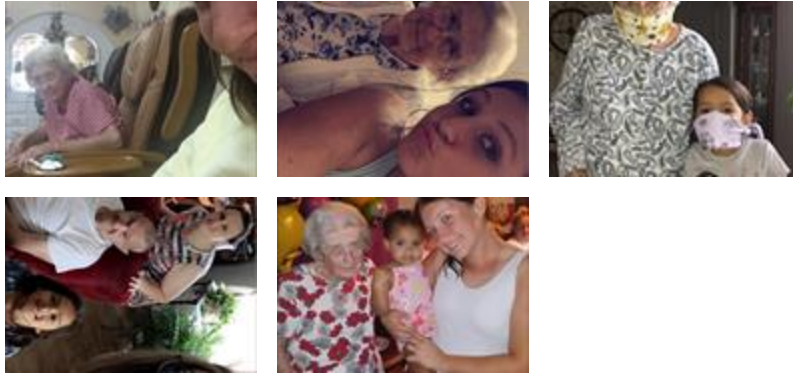
I am broken-hearted that we did not get to see each other in the last few years due to covid, but I am relieved that you are no longer suffering. You will live on in my heart until we meet again.
