



## Norman "Andy" Victor Anderson

December 24, 1925 - November 29, 2021

ANDERSON, Norman (Andy) Victor, 95, of Prattville, AL passed away peacefully at home on November 29, 2021. The son of Norwegian immigrants, Chief Master Sergeant Anderson fought in WWII, the Korean War and Vietnam, serving 32 years in the US Air Force, Civil Engineering. Andy then became the Building Engineer for the Alabama State Capital Complex serving four Governors until he retired at 75. He was a Master Mason, active in the Prattville Lions Club and Habitat for Humanity, avid fan of Auburn University, and a faithful member of the Prattville First United Methodist Church. Mr. Anderson was preceded in death by his parents Carl Johanson and Alda Katherine Anderson. He is survived by his loving wife of 66 years Joanne Eunice (Hayden) Anderson, sons Norman Carl Anderson (Ann Striplin) and James Philip Anderson (Sheila Howard), grandchildren Jakob Anderson (Miranda), Eric Anderson, Rebecca Gray (Matt), Joseph Anderson (Gabby), Rachel Anderson, Kari Anderson, Jesse Hallford, and Rachel Hallford, great-grandchildren Wiley Gray and Julianna Gray, and hundreds of Norwegian cousins.
