



## Ralph M Stewart Jr.

May 23, 1937 - January 20, 2016

Memorial service for Ralph M Stewart, Jr., 78, of Prattville, Alabama, will be Friday, January 22nd, 2016 at First Baptist Church, Prattville. Visitation is 1:00 p.m.-2:00 p.m. with the Memorial Service immediately following, Dr. Travis Coleman officiating. Mr. Stewart passed away January 20th at Prattville Baptist Hospital from complications associated with heart disease. He retired in 2013 as President of Agri Insurance Southeast which he founded in 1995. Prior to entering the Property & Casualty Insurance industry in 1960, he served his country as a 2nd generation Marine. He sat on the Advisory Board of Penn Millers Insurance Company in Philadelphia, PA. He also served on the Board of Directors at Prattville Country Club and devoted countless hours to the Prattville Quarterback Club and West Point Quarterback Club where he served as President of both. He was an avid golfer and South Carolina Gamecock fan as well as a scholarship donar for 20+ years. One of his greatest Gamecock moments was seeing his grandson, Lane, who played at South Carolina run out of the tunnel to the tune of 2001 Space Oddysey.

He met his future wife, Nickie Johnson in Bennettsville, SC where she was a sophomore in high school and married her 3 years later. They had been married for 60 years at the time of his death.
