THORN, Timothy Louis, 62, resident of Deatsville, AL, passed away on Sunday, March 1, 2026. Mr. Thorn was preceded in death by his parents, Bill and Lee Thorn; brothers, William Henry Thorn III and Brett Thomas Thorn; sister, Sherlyn Delene “Dee” Thorn; two nephews, Douglas and Whitman Thorn. Tim was born on May 22, 1963 in Montgomery, Alabama, and was raised in Millbrook, AL , until 1971, when the family moved to Brewton, Alabama, where his father worked as a state revenue auditor. Upon graduating in 1981, he enlisted in the United States Army, where he served 3 years (including one year in Korea) as an E4, 67 Tango Tactical Transport Helicopter Repairer on UH-60 Black Hawk helicopters. He earned the Good Conduct Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, Expert (Rifle)/Marksman (Hand Grenade). He later served in the Alabama Army National Guard in Mobile and Montgomery as an E5 Crew Chief on UH-1

Huey helicopters.

He was an excellent industrial maintenance mechanic, and worked for several companies, including Georgia Pacific (Monroeville), Webster Industries (Montgomery), Wright Plastics (Prattville), UPS (Birmingham, 10 years), Genpak (Montgomery), Medline Industries (Prattville) and Hyundai Motor Co. (Montgomery)
