Walter Andrew Linch, Jr., 69, a resident of Prattville, Alabama, passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, September 27, 2024. Walt, or Andy, as he was known to many of his family and friends, was born in Phoenix, Arizona to Walter A. Linch, Sr and Barbara (Ralston) Linch, on November 3, 1954.

Mr. Linch graduated from Perry Christian School (Marion, AL), with the class of 1972. After high school, he studied at the Marion Military Institute, Wallace Community College, and the University of Montevallo.

Mr. Linch was a heavily decorated veteran of the United States Armed Forces, having served for nearly 40 years, with almost 30 of those years as full time status with the Alabama Air National Guard. He was honored with 21 awards during his outstanding career and served three separate tours in Operation Enduring Iraqi Freedom. Serving our nation was one of his greatest passions.

After retirement, he enjoyed spending time with, and caring for, his large network of family and friends. His interests included fishing, competing in barbecue cook offs, and watching any sport related to the University of Alabama. He is remembered for his strong Christian faith, as well as his witty and jovial-spirit, positive influence on others, and endless generosity.

He is preceded in death by his parents; son, Joshua Linch, and sister; Nancy

(Linch) Gunter. He is survived by three daughters; Gina Rommel-Vlahakis (Greg), Jacquelyn McDonald (Michael), and Jamie Linch; one son, James Linch; five grandchildren, Ayasha Burton, Stella McDonald, Troy McDonald, Erich Rommel, and Hayleigh Rommel; one great-grandchild, Kameron McDonald; one sister, Alice Mobley; two brothers, Frank Linch and David Linch; and a host of extended family and friends.

A celebration of life will be held at Prattville Memorial Chapel on Sunday, November 3, 2024 with visitation from 1:00 pm until 2:00 pm and memorial service at 2:00 pm. The burial with full military honors, will take place on Monday, November 4, 2024 at 11:00 am at the Alabama National Cemetery, in Montevallo, AL.

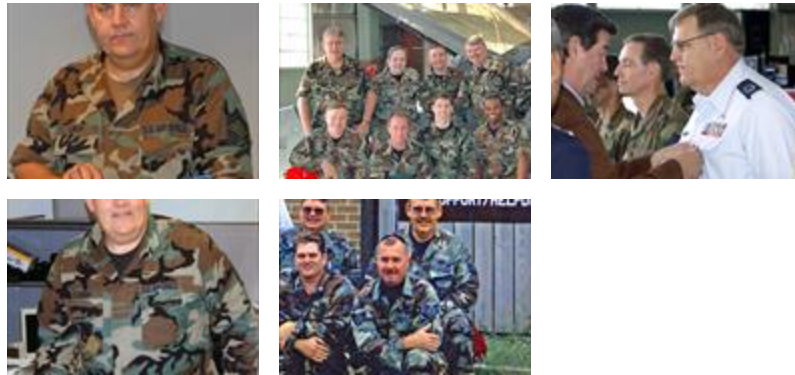
