



Weldon Dean Hargrove

April 27, 1931 - October 24, 2018

HARGROVE, Weldon Dean, born April 27, 1931. He went to meet the Lord face-to-face on Wednesday, October 24th of this year at the age of 87. Funeral services will be held on Saturday, October 27, 2018 from Prattville Church of Christ at 3:00 p.m. with Minister Brent Missildine officiating. Visitation will be held at the church on Saturday from 1:30 until 3:00 p.m. Burial will follow at Prattville Memory Gardens with Prattville Memorial directing. Mr. Hargrove was preceded in death by his parents, James Arlie and Ahleen (Oliver) Hargrove; his brothers, Doyle and Gail; and his first wife, Glenda (Brasell) Hargrove. He is survived by his loving wife of 26 years, Rebecca Joyce Hargrove; son, Reggie (Annette); daughter, Rhonda Thompson; six stepchildren, Bruce, Mark (Jacque), David (Michele), Janet Gray (Joey), Diane, and Kristy Payton (Greg); three grandchildren, Rachel Hargrove, Chad Thompson, and Cody Thompson; step-grandchildren, Trent Williams; Heath and Blake Williams; Ashley Walker, Christopher Williams, Jamie Grizzell, Alex Williams; Wesley and Reed Tomlin; Jolie and Joseph Gray; several great-grandchildren; extended family and many friends. Weldon lived most of his life on West Texas farms, though he did work in a carbon black plant as a young man, in a New Mexico potash mine, on an oil rig, as a TV repairman, and other jobs when farming was not a financial option for his family. He and Glenda also worked at the Children's Home in Lubbock, TX for 12 years where he worked as the farm manager and 4-H sponsor. When he and Glenda moved to Montgomery, AL in January 1983, he used his

many skills as a self-taught plumber, electrician, carpenter, and general Jack-of-all-trades (and genuinely master-of-all of them) for the maintenance department at Faulkner University.

Weldon will be remembered for his dry wit, his loving and generous heart, and his hard work. His hand-made wooden crafts are treasured by friends and family in many different parts of the country.
